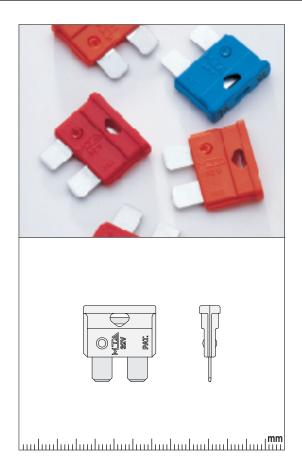

This fuse is designed to interrupt electrical short circuits or prescribed overload current. The correspondence between current intensity and time complies with international standard reference (see the curves for details).

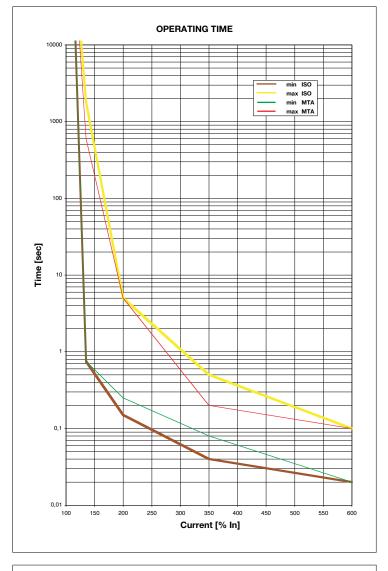
This fuse device presents very good characteristics of reliability, mounting and substitution in maintenance operations and the production process guarantees high level in standard performances of the product.

The object performs correct protection with a maximum voltage of 32 Vdc.

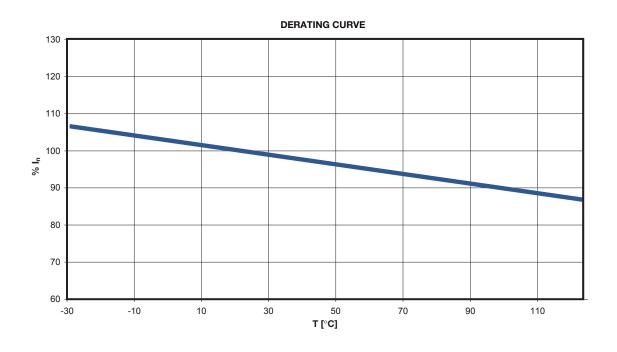

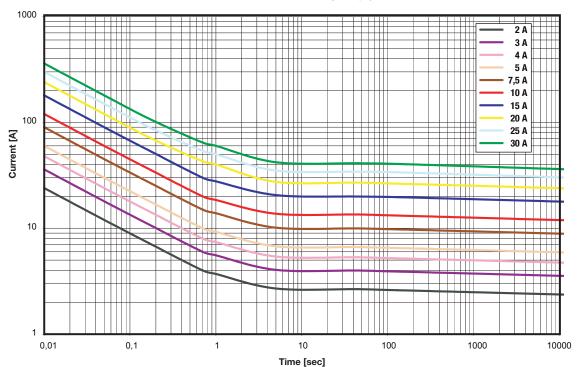
